Species: Beef & Lamb



### About

The Southwest Junior Livestock show, including Iron, Beaver and Washington counties in Utah and Lincoln County Nevada, has a rich history of livestock production. To honor this history and recognize those producing excellent livestock, Western AgCredit has created a Bred and Fed competition.

This competition is for beef and lamb. The intent of the competition is to recognize ranching families that bring their home-raised projects to the fair. Exhibitors who have purchased a calf or lamb born in Iron, Beaver, Washington or Lincoln Counties are also eligible to enter.

### How to Enter

At final weigh-in in September, a Western AgCredit representative will be present. Sign the affidavit stating that your beef or lamb will meet all criteria outlined, and you'll be entered in the competition.

### Winner Selection

The winner of the Bred and Fed competition will be the highest placing beef and lamb in the market class meeting the rules as outlined.

### Rules



The animal must have been born in Iron, Beaver, Washington or Lincoln Counties.



Calves/lambs can leave the listed counties for summer grazing if the ranch is headquartered in one of the counties noted.



After the calf/lamb is weaned, it must be fed in the listed counties.



The exhibitor must adhere to all Rules and Policies stated by the Southwest Junior Livestock Sale Committee.



The exhibitor signs an affidavit confirming the above rules are met at the weigh-in for the Southwest Junior Livestock Sale.

### Prize \$\$

The winning exhibitor for each species will be awarded **\$1,500** in prize money, and the exhibitor and breeder will also receive custom jackets.
